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Archives of Neuropsychiatry (Arch Neuropsychiatry) is the official journal of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society. It is published quarterly. Annually four editions and supplementary editions constitute a volume. The publication language of the journal is Turkish and English.

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Research Articles: The main text of research articles should be organized under the subtitles of *Introduction*, *Methods*, *Results*, and *Discussion*. The Introduction should include the rationale of the study, and the objective should be clearly stated in the last paragraph. The “Methods” section may include subsections describing the participants, instruments, and the statistical methods. The “Results” section includes the findings of the study, supported with tables and figures to facilitate viewing. The “Discussion” should include the authors’ conclusions, limitations of the study and a comparison with the relevant literature. *Please check Table 1 below for word count specifications.*

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All acronyms and abbreviations used in the manuscript should be defined at first use, both in the abstract and in the main text. The abbreviation should be provided in parentheses following the definition.

When a drug, product, hardware, or software program is mentioned within the main text, product information, including the name of the product, the producer of the product, and city and the country of the company (including the state if in USA), should be provided in parentheses in the following format: "Discovery St PET/CT scanner (General Electric, Milwaukee, WI, USA)" All references, tables, and figures should be referred to within the main text, and they should be numbered consecutively in the order they are referred to within the main text.

The limitations and insufficiencies of original research should be mentioned in the "Discussion" section before the "Conclusion" paragraph.

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While citing, preference should be given to the latest, most up-to-date publications. If an ahead-of-print publication is cited, the DOI number should be provided. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of references. Journal titles should be abbreviated in accordance with the journal abbreviations in Index Medicus/MEDLINE/PubMed. In articles with 6 or less authors, all authors should be listed in each reference. In articles with more than 6 authors, sixth authors' name should be followed by "et al.". In the main text of the manuscript, references should be cited using Arabic numbers in parentheses. Reference styles for different types of publications are presented in the following examples.
