# **Aims and Scope**

Archives of Neuropsychiatry (Arch Neuropsychiatry) is the official journal of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society. It is published quarterly, and four editions annually constitute a volume.

Archives of Neuropsychiatry is a peer reviewed scientific journal that publishes articles on psychiatry, neurology, and behavioural sciences. Both clinical and basic science contributions are welcomed. Submissions that address topics in the interface of neurology and psychiatry are encouraged. The content covers original research articles, reviews, letters to the editor, and case reports.

The audience of the journal includes neurologists, psychiatrists, and other scientists and clinicians working in related fields.

The editorial and publication processes of the journal are shaped in accordance with the guidelines of the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE), World Association of Medical Editors (WAME), Council of Science Editors (CSE), Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), European Association of Science Editors (EASE), and National Information Standards Organization (NISO). The journal is in conformity with the Principles of Transparency and Best Practice in Scholarly Publishing (doaj.org/bestpractice).

The Archives of Neuropsychiatry is indexed in Science Citation Index-Expanded (SCI-E), PubMed Central, Journal Citation Reports/ Science Edition, EMBASE, ProQuest, SCOPUS, EBSCO, PSYCHinfo, CINAHL, Gale/Cengage Learning, Turkish Psychiatry Index, TUBITAK ULAKBIM TR Index and Turkiye Citation Index.

All manuscripts must be submitted via the online submission system, which is available at www.noropsikiyatriarsivi.com. The journal guidelines, technical information, and the required forms are available on the journal's web page.

All expenses of the journal are covered by the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society. Print and online advertisements of medical products and devices can be published in the journal. Editor-in-Chiefs have full and final authority for approving print and online advertisements with confirmations from executive committee of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society for financial and bureaucratic process. Potential advertisers are advised to contact the executive committee of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society.

For all articles submitted as of September 1, 2018 and accepted for publication after the scientific evaluation, the journal of Archives of Neuropsychiatry will charge a fee of 200 USD for members of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society and 250 USD for non-members as article publishing charge (APC). For the authors who has also served as a reviewer for Archives of Neuropsychiatry in the last 3 years, APC is 150 USD.

# **PUBLICATION PROCESS**

The editorial and publication processes of the journal are shaped in accordance with the guidelines of the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE), World Association of Medical Editors (WAME), Council of Science Editors (CSE), Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), European Association of Science Editors (EASE), and National Information Standards Organization (NISO). Besides, the preparation of the journal is in conformity with the Principles of Transparency and Best Practice in Scholarly Publishing (doaj.org/bestpractice).

Submissions are reviewed for their originality and scientific quality. Manuscripts submitted should not have been previously published in any electronic or printed media, nor should be under evaluation process with another journal. Authors may wish to inform the reviewers of the journal on their previously evaluated and unaccepted manuscripts. The submission of previous reviewer reports will expedite the evaluation process. Manuscripts that have been presented at scientific meetings should be accompanied by information about the organization, including the name, date, and location of the meeting.

The articles submitted to Archives of Neuropsychiatry are evaluated for scientific quality and originality. The editorial board completes an initial evaluation of papers for their originality, methodology, the importance of the topic covered, and its relevance to the aim and scopes of the journal. Articles that meet the scientific publication standards of the journal are assigned to two or more independent experts in the field for double-blind peer-review process. The decision about the publication of manuscripts is based on independent, unbiased, double-blind reviewers' reports. For all submissions, the Editors in Chief are the final authorities in the decision-making process. The editorial board will invite an external and independent editor to manage the evaluation processes of manuscripts submitted by editors or editorial board members of the journal.

Approval of research protocols by the Ethics Committee in accordance with international agreements of World Medical Association Declaration of Helsinki "Ethical Principles for Medical Research Involving Human Subjects" (October 2024), is required for experimental, clinical, and drug studies and for some case reports. If required, ethics committee report or an equivalent official document must be provided by the authors. For experimental human research studies, a statement should be included in the manuscript depicting written informed consent of patients and volunteers has been obtained following a detailed explanation of the procedures that they may undergo. For animal studies, the measures taken to prevent pain and suffering of the animals should

be stated clearly. Information on patient consent, the name of the ethics committee, and the ethics committee approval number should also be stated in the Materials and Methods section of the manuscript. It is the authors' responsibility to carefully protect the patients' anonymity. For photographs that may reveal the identity of the patients, signed releases of the patient and/or of their legal representatives should be enclosed.

Every research involving human subjects must be registered in a public database in accordance with the Helsinki Declaration before the enrollment of the first participant. All clinical trials must be registered in the World Health Organization's "International Clinical Trial Registry Platform" or an equivalent public database, in compliance with ICMJE criteria. For clinical trials conducted in Turkey, additional approval must be obtained from the Turkish Medicines and Medical Devices Agency. The registration numbers of the clinical trials should be included at the end of the "Abstract" section.

If artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning or similar technologies has been used to write and/or edit the manuscript, the name and version of the AI tool, along with the AI-generated content included in the paper should be explained in the methods section. In addition, an acknowledgements section should be added which discloses that an AI tool has been used to create the manuscript and states that authors take full responsibility for the AI-generated content and both the technology used and the content generated by it is explained in methods section. The same acknowledgement must also be included in the cover letter that will be sent to the editors during submission.

All submissions are screened by a similarity detection software (iThenticate by CrossCheck).

Affiliations: Authors must list the institution where the work was done along with their current institution.

If there is a dispute about any kind of authorship issues during review process or after acceptance and publication, Archives of Neuropsychiatry won't be in a position to investigate or adjudicate. Authors are expected to resolve authorship disputes themselves. If needed, the Journal reserves the right to contact related institutions and reject or retract the articles.

In the event of alleged or suspected research misconduct, e.g., plagiarism, citation manipulation, and data falsification/fabrication, the Editorial Board will follow and act in accordance with COPE guidelines. All appeal and complaint cases are handled within the scope of COPE guidelines by the Editorial Board. In such cases, authors could get in contact with the editorial office regarding their appeals and complaints. When necessary, the editorial board can correspond with COPE to resolve cases that cannot be resolved internally. In this case, COPE's recommendation will be considered as the final decision.

Each individual listed as an author should fulfill the authorship criteria recommended by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE - www.icmje.org). The ICMJE recommends that authorship be based on the following 4 criteria:

- Substantial contributions to the conception or design of the work; or the acquisition, analysis, or interpretation of data for the work: AND
- 2. Drafting the work or revising it critically for important intellectual content; AND
- 3. Final approval of the version to be published; AND
- Agreement to be accountable for all aspects of the work in ensuring that questions related to the accuracy or integrity of any part of the work are appropriately investigated and resolved.

In addition to being accountable for the parts of the work he/she has done, an author should be able to identify which co-authors are responsible for specific parts of the work. In addition, authors should have confidence in the integrity of the contributions of their co-authors. All those designated as authors should meet all four criteria for authorship, and all who meet the four criteria should be identified as authors. Those who do not meet all four criteria should be acknowledged in the title page of the manuscript.

At initial submission Archives of Neuropsychiatry expects from corresponding authors a signed and scanned version of the authorship contribution form (available for download through www.noropsikiyatriarsivi.com) in order to act appropriately on authorship rights and to prevent ghost or honorary authorship. If the editorial board suspects a case of "gift authorship," the submission will be rejected without further review. As part of the submission of the manuscript, the corresponding author should also send a short statement declaring that they agree to undertake all the responsibility for authorship during the submission and evaluation of the manuscript.

When a large multi-author group has conducted the work, the group ideally should decide who will be an author before the work is started and confirm who is an author before submitting the manuscript for publication. All members of the group named as authors should meet all four criteria for authorship. They will also be expected as individuals to complete disclosure forms. Some large multi-author groups designate author ship by a group name, with or without the names of individuals. When submitting a manuscript authored by a group, the corresponding author should specify the group name if one exists, and clearly identify the group members who can take credit and responsibility for the work as authors.

Archives of Neuropsychiatry requires and encourages the authors and the individuals involved in the evaluation process of submitted manuscripts to disclose any existing or potential conflicts of interests, including financial, consultant, and institutional, that might lead to potential bias or a conflict of interest. Any financial grants or other support received for a submitted study from individuals or institutions should be disclosed to the Editorial Board. To disclose potential conflicts of interest, the ICMJE Potential Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form should be filled in and submitted by all contributing authors. Cases of a potential conflict of interest of the editors, authors, or reviewers are resolved by the journal's Editorial Board within the scope of COPE and ICMJE guidelines.

At the submission stage, manuscripts may be submitted to the journal in either Turkish or English. Following the completion of the evaluation process, articles accepted for publication will be published in both Turkish and English. Authors are required to provide the English translation for accepted Turkish manuscripts and the Turkish translation for accepted English manuscripts. For English manuscripts submitted from outside Turkey and accepted for publication, if none of the authors possess proficiency in Turkish, the Turkish translation will be provided by the journal.

By submitting a manuscript to Archives of Neuropsychiatry, authors accept to assign the copyright of their manuscript to the Turkish

Neuropsychiatric Society. If rejected for publication, the copyright of the manuscript will be assigned back to the authors. Archives of Neuropsychiatry requires each submission to be accompanied by a Copyright Transfer Form (available for download at www. noropsikiyatriarsivi.com). When using previously published content, including figures, tables, or any other material in both print and electronic formats, authors must obtain permission from the copyright holder. Legal, financial and criminal liabilities in this regard belong to the author(s).

Any opinions and views expressed in the articles published by the journal are the views and opinions of the author(s), and not views of or endorsed by the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Society, editors, editorial board, and/or publisher; the editors, editorial board, and publisher disclaim any responsibility or liability for such materials.

# **MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION**

The manuscripts should be prepared in accordance with ICMJE-Recommendations for the Conduct, Reporting, Editing, and Publication of Scholarly Work in Medical Journals (updated in January 2025 - http://www.icmje.org/icmje-recommendations.pdf). Authors are required to prepare manuscripts in accordance with the CONSORT guidelines for randomized research studies, STROBE guidelines for observational original research studies, STARD guidelines for studies on diagnostic accuracy, PRISMA guidelines for systematic reviews and meta-analysis, ARRIVE guidelines for experimental animal studies, TREND guidelines for non-randomized public behavior, and CARE guidelines for case reports.

Manuscripts can only be submitted through the journal's online manuscript submission and evaluation system, available at www. noropsikiyatriarsivi.com. Manuscripts submitted via any other medium will not be evaluated.

Manuscripts submitted to the journal will first go through a technical evaluation process where the editorial office staff will ensure that the manuscript has been prepared and submitted in accordance with the journal's guidelines. Submissions that do not conform to the journal's guidelines will be returned to the submitting author with technical correction requests.

The authors must upload the Copyright Transfer Form, Author Contribution Form and ICMJE Potential Conflicts of Interest Form (this form must be filled in by all authors) to the online article system during the first submission. These forms are available at www.noropsikiyatriarsivi.com.

A separate "title page" file saved in Microsoft Word format (docx) should be submitted with all submissions. Title page must include:

- The full title of the manuscript as well as a short title (running head) of no more than 50 characters,
- Name(s), affiliations (institution where the work was done and the current institution), and highest academic degree(s) of the author(s),
- Grant information and detailed information on the other sources of support,
- Name, address, telephone numbers (including the mobile phone) and e-mail address of the corresponding author,
- Acknowledgment of the individuals who contributed to the preparation of the manuscript but who do not fulfill the authorship criteria.

# PREPARATION OF THE MANUSCRIPT

Articles should be written with "Times New Roman" character, 12 font size and 1.5 line spacing and saved in Microsoft Word format (docx). All acronyms and abbreviations used in the manuscript

should be defined at first use, both in the abstract and in the main text. The abbreviation should be provided in parentheses following the definition.

When a drug, product, hardware, or software program is mentioned within the main text, product information, including the name of the product, the producer of the product, and city and the country of the company (including the state if in USA), should be provided in parentheses in the following format: "Discovery St PET/CT scanner (General Electric, Milwaukee, WI, USA)"All references, tables, and figures should be referred to within the main text, and they should be numbered consecutively in the order they are referred to within the main text.

Statistical analyses must be conducted in accordance with international statistical reporting standards (see; Altman DG, Gore SM, Gardner MJ, Pocock SJ. Statistical guidelines for contributors to medical journals. Br Med J 1983: 7; 1489-93). The statistical software that was used must be specified.

Units should be prepared in accordance with the International System of Units (SI).

**Title:** Titles of articles should be both concise yet comprehensive and descriptive. Titles framed as questions are only accepted for articles submitted in "letter to the editor" format.

**Abstract:** An English abstract should accompany all submissions except for Letters to the Editor. Abstracts in Turkish are not expected from international authors. The abstract of Original Articles and Review Articles must be structured with subheadings (Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusion). The abstract of case reports must be structured with subheadings (Introduction, Case and Conclusion). Abstracts should be within the word limit of 250-300. Please check Table 1 below for the details.

**Keywords:** Each submission must be accompanied by a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 6 keywords listed in alphabetical order at the end of the abstract. The keywords should be selected from the National Library of Medicine, Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) database (https://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/MBrowser.html).

**Highlights:** This section is of high prominence for the discoverability of the articles via search engines and for the promotion of the articles in digital media. 3 to 5 highlights should be provided for each article including research articles, case reports, reviews and letters to the editor. Highlights can be novel results, novel methods used or striking findings and important conclusions of the article. They should be written as short sentences of maximum 85 characters (including spaces) and organized as a bulleted list.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to make any modifications it deems appropriate to the "title," "keywords," and "highlights" informing authors of the changes.

# **Manuscript Types**

**Research Articles:** The main text of research articles should be organized under the subtitles of Introduction, Methods, Results,

and Discussion. The Introduction should include the rationale of the study, and the objective and hypothesis of the study should be clearly stated in the last paragraph. The "Methods" section must include the subsections of "participants", "design", "instruments", "statistics" and "ethics". The "Results" section includes the findings of the study, supported with tables and figures to facilitate reading. The "Discussion" should include the authors' conclusions, limitations and strengths of the study and a comparison with the relevant literature. Please check Table 1 below for word count specifications.

**Review Articles:** These are articles that explain, discuss, evaluate topics within the journal's scope in light of current information, and offer suggestions for potential future studies. Review authors must be experts whose knowledge on the subject is reflected in international publications and high citation counts. Authors meeting these criteria may be invited by the Editorial Board to write review articles. For reviews submitted without an invitation from the Editorial Board, it is expected that at least one of the authors has published three or more original research studies related to the topic. These articles should include the following subheadings: "Introduction," "Method," "Results," and "Discussion." Word count limitations for review articles are outlined in Table 1.

Case Reports: There is limited space for case reports in the journal. Reports on rare cases or conditions that constitute challenges in diagnosis and treatment, those offering new therapies or revealing knowledge not included in the literature, and interesting and educative case reports are accepted for review. The text should include the subheadings "Introduction", "Case Presentation", and "Discussion". Please check Table 1 below for word count specifications.

**Brief Reports:** These are manuscripts that report either original research or novel ideas dealing with important theoretical or practical problems related to specific subjects. Brief report articles (excluding title page, references, table / figure / picture) should not exceed 2500 words. Please check Table 1 below for word count specifications

**Letters to the Editor:** These manuscripts include evaluation and criticisms submitted by the experts in the field or the reviewers of a manuscript regarding manuscripts previously published in the journal. The authors of manuscripts that become topics of letters to the editor are provided with the opportunity to responds to the comments that are raised. Letters are published together with the responses of the author(s) of the manuscript concerned where possible.

# **Special Section**

**Introduction of websites:** These manuscripts introduce websites relevant to the scope of the journal.

**Book Section:** These manuscripts introduce the books/theses published on subjects related to the scope of the journal. The text of manuscripts in the special section must not exceed 500 words (excluding the references, tables, and figures or legends). Up to five references and either one table or one figure are allowed.

#### **Tables**

Tables should be included in the main document, presented after the reference list, and they should be numbered consecutively in the order they are referred to within the main text. A descriptive title must be placed above the tables. Abbreviations used in the tables should be defined below the tables by footnotes (even if they are defined within the main text). These abbreviations should be listed in alphabetical order and separated by semicolons (ADHD: Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder; OCD: Obsessive Compulsive Disorder). Tables should be created using the "insert table" command of the word processing software and they should be arranged clearly to provide easy reading. Data presented in the tables should not be a repetition of the data presented within the main text but should be supporting the main text.

# **Figures and Figure Legends**

Figures, graphics, and photographs should be submitted as separate files (in TIFF or IPEG format) through the submission system. The files should not be embedded in a Word document or the main document. When there are figure subunits, the subunits should not be merged to form a single image. Each subunit should be submitted separately through the submission system. Images should not be labelled (a, b, c, etc.) to indicate figure subunits. Thick and thin arrows, arrowheads, stars, asterisks, and similar marks can be used on the images to support figure legends. Like the rest of the submission, the figures should be blind. Any information within the images that may indicate an individual or an institution should be blinded. For this reason, the persons in the pictures should not be recognized and institutional information should also be deleted. The minimum resolution of each submitted figure should be 300 DPI. To prevent delays in the evaluation process, all submitted figures should be clear in resolution and large in size (minimum dimensions: 100 × 100 mm). Figure legends should be listed at the end of the main document.

#### References

While citing, preference should be given to the latest, most upto-date publications. If an ahead-of-print publication is cited, the DOI number should be provided. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of references. Journal titles should be abbreviated in accordance with the journal abbreviations in Index Medicus/MEDLINE/PubMed. In articles with 6 or less authors, all authors should be listed in each reference. In articles with more than 6 authors, sixth authors' name should be followed by "et al.". In the main text of the manuscript, references should be cited using Arabic numbers in parentheses. Reference styles for different types of publications are presented in the following examples.

# **REVISIONS**

In the revised files prepared based on the reviewers comments, all changes made to the main text must be clearly marked in a different color or saved in "track changes" format. Notes addressing the reviewers' suggestions and comments must be included in a separate document titled "Revision Notes." In this document, each reviewer's comment should first be stated, followed by the author's response. Additionally, the specific line numbers where changes have been made should be indicated.

Revised manuscripts must be submitted within three months following the notification letter requesting revisions. If the revisions are not submitted within the specified period, the evaluation process may be terminated. Should the authors require an extension for submitting revisions, they must notify the journal of their request prior to the expiration of the three-month deadline.

Manuscripts accepted for publication are copy-edited for grammar, punctuation, and formatting. The print-ready PDF versions of accepted manuscripts are sent to the corresponding authors, who are required to return their approval to the journal within two days. Articles are made available in an early online format on the journal's website prior to the publication of the issue in which they are included.

#### **ARTICLE PROCESSING CHARGES**

An article processing fee is charged for all types of manuscripts accepted for publication following the scientific evaluation process. The article processing charge (APC) is \$200 USD for members of the Turkish Neuropsychiatric Association and \$250 USD for non-members. Authors who have served as reviewers for Archives of Neuropsychiatry within the past three years are entitled to a reduced APC of \$150 USD, applicable to their first manuscript submission.
